Front-End Loader (Skid Steer) - LS	
Overview	Participants will gain a sound understanding of the Front-End Loader operations and responsibilities. The Front End Loader assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration, verbal questioning and written testing and calculations, and the ability to perform tasks to the National Occupational Health & Safety Standard and Worksafe Victoria Standards.
Duration	½ day (experienced operators) 5 days (no experience)
Learning Outcomes	On completion of this course, participants will be able to manage: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Planning and preparing</li> <li>Conducting machine pre-operational checks</li> <li>Operating front end loaders</li> <li>Attaching, securing, lifting, carrying and placing materials</li> <li>Selecting, removing and fitting attachments</li> <li>Relocating the front end loader</li> <li>Carrying out machine operator maintenance and clean up.</li> </ul>
